



Duties of the Coach for Coastal "A" Cup 2018

All teams must complete a team "Roster Form" and forward to peterrprice@shaw.ca

Home teams:

- Must report the game time and venue 6 days before the game day to **Your Cup Coordinators** and the **opposition**.

Before the game:

- Have all player ID cards.
- Make sure you have a contact for all teams your division. Check at www.bccoastalcup.com or contact your Coordinator.
- The home team must contact (by phone) the opposition by Thursday before the game to confirm time and venue. ***(If you leave a voice message request a phone call back.)***
- If you have not been contacted by the home team by Thursday contact them to confirm the game
- It is the home team that supplies the assistant referees. Check with your referee assignor.
- If you wish to use players on permit, all Coastal Cup Permit rules must be followed, and the Coastal Cup Permit form must be completed, approved and submitted 48 hours prior to the game.
- Download the Cup "Roster Form" from the "Rules" page on www.bccoastalcup.com. Fill in your team list (***all boxes***) and give two copies to the referee before the start of the game. If you have any players on Permit you must give two copies to the Referee. **Do not add Permit players to the roster.** He will give a copy to the other team's coach with the roster and a copy of their list to you.
- Control your players, parents and supporters. Teams will be fined for inappropriate behavior.

After the game:

- Both teams report the score to your Cup Coordinators no later than 6:00 pm on the day of game.

What not to do:

- **Do not cancel** any games without checking the procedures with your Coordinator
- **Do not reschedule** any games without permission of the Coordinator
- If time or venue has to change you must inform your Coordinator, the referee scheduler, and your opponents. **(BY PHONE) ASAP**
- Players under suspension must sit out and not play in games.
- All players sent off (red card) **must sit out your next game** and attend a discipline hearing. Discipline hearings are dealt with by BC Soccer.
- **Lower Mainland "A" Cup** Referees must be paid in cash before the game or at half-time by the home team.
